## **Sherwin Watches His Fanbase Grow**

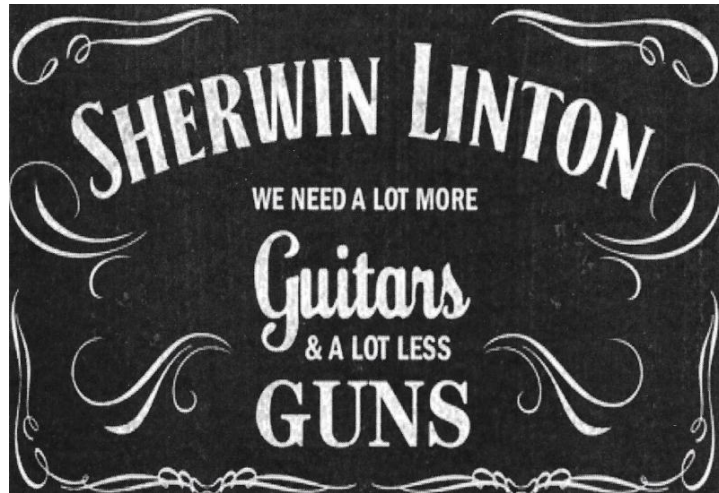

## **Sherwin Featured in History of Country Music TV Show**

This fall PBS will broadcast the new Ken Burns project "Country Music The Film." This multi part feature is sure to be exciting for ALL interested in the roots and history of Country Music a uniquely American art form. From southern Appalachia's songs of struggle, heartbreak and faith to the rollicking western swing of Texas, from California honky tonks to Nashville's Grand Ole Opry, Burns film follows the evolution of Country Music over the course of the twentieth century, as it eventually emerged to become America's music.

The midwest is also rich in Country Music history and Pioneer Public Television will air a 30 minute documentary of Country Music's midwestern connection hosted by KARE-11 anchor Diana Pierce. Sherwin is participating as an advisor for this project and also filmed a short segment. Look for this to air in September prior to the Ken Burns film on Pioneer Public Television. 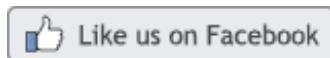
